SUBJECT: **Report of the investigation of an allegation of sexual exploitation and abuse**
OBJET: **against a [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED]**

1. The Investigations Division of the Office of Internal Oversight Services (ID/OIOS) received from the [REDACTED] in the [REDACTED] an allegation of sexual exploitation and abuse against a [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] identified by ID/OIOS as [REDACTED]. It was alleged that [REDACTED] was involved in a sexual relationship with a [REDACTED] year-old [REDACTED] national, [REDACTED] with whom [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] a child.

2. ID/OIOS conducted an investigation of the allegation, which included, but was not limited to, the interview of [REDACTED] other civilian witnesses and UN personnel, the collection and analysis of available documents and identification of the subject via a photograph array.

3. ID/OIOS has concluded its investigation, which found that:

a. [REDACTED] initially [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] with the [REDACTED] and was integrated, as part of the [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] was [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] on [REDACTED]

b. In [REDACTED] [REDACTED] met [REDACTED] and the two engaged in a consensual sexual relationship and that, thereafter, [REDACTED] admitted to being married, but promised to assist [REDACTED] in migrating to [REDACTED] saying that [REDACTED] would finance a business enterprise for [REDACTED] and continue the relationship despite [REDACTED] marriage.

c. In [REDACTED] [REDACTED] learned that [REDACTED] was having an affair with another [REDACTED]

d. In [REDACTED] [REDACTED] ascertained that [REDACTED] was pregnant, but, when informed of the pregnancy, [REDACTED] denied [REDACTED] and became hostile towards [REDACTED]

e. [REDACTED] refused to assist [REDACTED] with medical expenses arising from the pregnancy and birth of the child; however, [REDACTED] did inform [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] and gave [REDACTED] telephone number.

- f. [REDACTED] gave birth to a [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]
- g. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both positively identified - by means of a photograph identification procedure - [REDACTED] as being the [REDACTED] with whom [REDACTED] had had the consensual sexual relationship and against whom [REDACTED] was lodging [REDACTED] claim.
- h. An examination of the messages received on [REDACTED]'s cellular telephone revealed that, following the birth of [REDACTED] child, [REDACTED] allegedly sent [REDACTED] messages to [REDACTED] the last being on [REDACTED] in which [REDACTED] comments about the good memories of their lovemaking but does not inquire about the child.
- i. In the absence of an acknowledgement of [REDACTED] or DNA testing, ID/OIOS is unable to make a conclusive finding with respect to [REDACTED] against [REDACTED]

4. ID/OIOS made numerous attempts, for the purpose of interview, to contact [REDACTED] via [REDACTED] alleged [REDACTED] telephone number without success; therefore [REDACTED] has not been interviewed regarding the [REDACTED] and further action in this regard is thus required by the [REDACTED] and the [REDACTED]

5. Notwithstanding that [REDACTED] alleged conduct - with respect to entering into a sexual relationship with a [REDACTED] - is of the type "strongly discouraged" by ST/SGB/2003/13, ID/OIOS concludes that the allegation of sexual exploitation and abuse against [REDACTED] is unsubstantiated. However, ID/OIOS recommends (ID Rec. No. IV06/059/01) that the [REDACTED] raised against [REDACTED] be referred to the [REDACTED] for any action deemed appropriate. Your response with respect to any action taken or considered in this matter by [REDACTED] would be greatly appreciated.
