It may be noted that the Commission's LOGFRAME are developed through RBM approach, and undergo stringent (in-house) validation by OPM, harmonization at PPBD and approval through various Committees (including CPC). The fact that African Development Forum is implemented by different sub-programmes (considered most appropriate to the theme), in itself is a proof that these conferences have clear linkage to the Objectives and Expected Accomplishments of the responsible sub-programme. Similarly Science with Africa-II held in 2010, resulted from the recommendation of the Science with Africa-I (held in 2008). The Output added at the discretion of the Secretariat contributes to the Expected Accomplishment#1 of the sub-programme (PPB:2010-2011), given below: <i>“Improved capacity of African countries to formulate, implement and evaluate inclusive and gender-sensitive national and sectoral information, communication and science, technology and innovation (STII) policies and strategies for development”</i>. Also please refer to the respective indicators of Achievement, which are directly related to the policies on Science.
