1. The Investigations Division of the Office of Internal Oversight Services (OIOS) received an allegation that on [REDACTED], a [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] assaulted a [REDACTED] (hereafter referred to as [REDACTED]) resulting in [REDACTED] hospitalization for [REDACTED]. The allegation was initially investigated by the [REDACTED] who found that the catalyst for the incident was a dispute over [REDACTED] (UN) [REDACTED] which [REDACTED] had agreed to provide to [REDACTED] based on the [REDACTED] investigation, found that [REDACTED] conduct was "a gross violation of [REDACTED] and amounts to serious misconduct under [REDACTED]

2. The OIOS has completed its investigation and concurs with the findings of the [REDACTED]. The OIOS notes that [REDACTED] was [REDACTED]

3. In addition, the OIOS established that standard operating procedures (SOPs) imposing curfews, rules on interaction with the local population and other issuances are promulgated by each incoming [REDACTED] and that the SOPs lapse upon [REDACTED]. The evidence adduced in this and other reported OIOS cases, namely [REDACTED] reinforces the general allegation that some [REDACTED] frequently disobeyed the SOPs promulgated by their [REDACTED] particularly those with respect to curfews and rules on interaction with the local population. Thus, the OIOS considers this is a [REDACTED] issue best addressed by the [REDACTED]
