SUBJECT: **Report of investigation into allegations of sexual exploitation by [REDACTED]**

1. On [REDACTED], the Investigations Division of the Office of Internal Oversight Services (ID/OIOS) received allegations of sexual exploitation from [REDACTED] against [REDACTED] a [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] a [REDACTED], both of whom were [REDACTED] but completed their [REDACTED] respectively.

2. It was alleged that [REDACTED] was involved in a sexual relationship with a [REDACTED] (hereafter referred to as [REDACTED]). It was alleged that [REDACTED] was involved in a sexual relationship with a [REDACTED]; however, no information as to the identity of [REDACTED] was provided to ID/OIOS and subsequent investigations could not identify [REDACTED].

3. ID/OIOS conducted an investigation into the allegations, which included, but was not limited to, the interview of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]; and the collection and analysis of available documents. ID/OIOS interviewed [REDACTED]; however, [REDACTED] could not be located pursuant to [REDACTED] and has not been interviewed about the allegation.

4. ID/OIOS has concluded its investigation, which found that [REDACTED]:

- a. [REDACTED] commenced a consensual sexual relationship with [REDACTED] when [REDACTED] was [REDACTED] [REDACTED]
- b. [REDACTED] maintained contact with [REDACTED] after [REDACTED] pursuant to the end of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] however, [REDACTED] renewed the sexual relationship with [REDACTED] upon [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

c. financially supported [redacted] and continues to do so despite the fact that [redacted] has returned to [redacted]. [redacted] has paid for [redacted] and, upon [redacted] left [redacted] a substantial amount of money for support;

d. intends to take [redacted] where they will [redacted] and [redacted] will become [redacted]

5. ID/OIOS found that circa [redacted] was found with a [redacted] national [redacted]. Upon direction, [redacted] escorted the [redacted] from the premises. The identity of [redacted] was not established at the time and ID/OIOS has been unable to locate and interview [redacted] to establish the identity of [redacted] and the nature of [redacted] relationship with [redacted]

6. Notwithstanding that [redacted] alleged conduct – with respect to entering into a sexual relationship with a [redacted] – is of the type “strongly discouraged” by ST/SGB/2003/13, ID/OIOS concludes that the allegation of sexual exploitation against [redacted] is unsubstantiated.

7. However, ID/OIOS concludes that [redacted] failed to comply with the [redacted] which prohibits fraternization between [redacted] and [redacted]. Accordingly, it is recommended that the [redacted] provide a copy of this report to the [redacted] for any action deemed appropriate against [redacted]

7. In the absence of the identification and interview of the [redacted] allegedly found in the [redacted] and in the absence of the interview of [redacted], ID/OIOS is unable to draw a conclusion on that allegation. Accordingly, ID/OIOS recommends that the [redacted] provide a copy of this report to the [redacted] for further action with respect to the interview of [redacted] and any action deemed appropriate. [redacted]
