SUBJECT: Report of the investigation of allegations of sexual exploitation and abuse
OBJET: against a

1. In [REDACTED] the Investigations Division of the Office of Internal Oversight Services (ID/OIOS) received an allegation from the [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] a [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] was involved in the sexual exploitation and abuse of young [REDACTED] who were allegedly seen both in [REDACTED] residence and in [REDACTED]-assigned vehicle.

2. ID/OIOS conducted an investigation into the allegation, which included, interviews with civilians, UN personnel and [REDACTED] a visit to [REDACTED] residence; and the collection and analysis of relevant documents and records.

3. ID/OIOS has concluded its investigation, which found:

a. That a witness [REDACTED] attested to seeing young [REDACTED] appearing between the ages of [REDACTED] visiting [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] residence on [REDACTED] separate occasions. On one occasion a [REDACTED] (aged between [REDACTED] years) asked for [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was a friend and had come to stay. [REDACTED] was subsequently directed to leave. On a [REDACTED] occasion, a [REDACTED] (aged between [REDACTED] years) asked for [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was a friend and had come to stay. [REDACTED] was also directed to leave. On the [REDACTED] occasion [REDACTED] attested to seeing a young [REDACTED] (aged between [REDACTED] years) in an [REDACTED] vehicle driven by [REDACTED] as it arrived at [REDACTED] residence and then leaving the following morning;

b. That another [REDACTED] attested to seeing a "young [REDACTED]" visiting [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] residence on one occasion;

c. No identification details with respect to the [REDACTED] listed above;

d. No evidence that [REDACTED] was actually engaged in sexual relations with young [REDACTED]

e. That staff at [redacted] residential [redacted] including [redacted] all denied seeing [redacted] with any [redacted] or seeing any [redacted] coming to [redacted] apartment to visit [redacted]. However, one [redacted] gave evidence that a young [redacted], aged about [redacted] had visited [redacted] on two occasions (both times arriving at the address on foot) and that [redacted] appeared to know exactly where [redacted] resided. The witness did not know when the [redacted] left [redacted] residence;

f. That [redacted] denied being involved with [redacted] denied having any [redacted] female visitors and further driving local [redacted] in [redacted] assigned vehicle. [redacted] stated that [redacted] rarely goes out, and when [redacted] does it is only for [redacted] in town.

4. ID/OIOS concludes that although the evidence adduced suggests that [redacted] may have been involved in sexual relationships, which are strongly discouraged, the evidence, being circumstantial and uncorroborated, is not sufficient to substantiate the allegations of sexual exploitation and abuse against [redacted]. ID/OIOS recommends that [redacted] be informed about the findings of this investigation ([redacted]).
