1. [REDACTED], the Investigations Division of the Office of Internal Oversight Services (ID/OIOS) received from [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]), allegations of sexual exploitation and assault against [REDACTED].

2. Specifically, it was alleged that a [REDACTED] (hereafter referred to as [REDACTED]) had engaged in a sexual relationship with [REDACTED] that resulted in [REDACTED] becoming [REDACTED]. It was further alleged that [REDACTED] had been assaulted by [REDACTED] upon informing [REDACTED].

3. ID/OIOS conducted an investigation of the allegations against [REDACTED], which included interviews with [REDACTED], and the review and analysis of relevant documents.

4. ID/OIOS has concluded its investigation and presents the following investigative findings:

5. [REDACTED] stated to ID/OIOS that while [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] met [REDACTED], and their meeting eventually developed into a consensual sexual relationship. Later, when [REDACTED] was [REDACTED] requested [REDACTED] to follow [REDACTED] which [REDACTED] did. The sexual relationship with [REDACTED] continued until [REDACTED] when [REDACTED] became [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was confirmed through a [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] further stated that when [REDACTED] informed [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] attitude towards [REDACTED] changed and [REDACTED] started seeing other [REDACTED]. When asked by ID/OIOS, [REDACTED] was unable to produce any document attesting to the [REDACTED] and results and could not recall the [REDACTED].

Conclusions and Recommendation

13. In light of the evidence set forth above, ID/OIOS concludes that, on balance, it is likely that [REDACTED] engaged in a consensual sexual relationship with [REDACTED]. However, ID/OIOS found no evidence to support a finding that the sexual relationship was of an exploitative nature. There is also no evidence that [REDACTED] was [REDACTED]. Accordingly, ID/OIOS concludes that the allegation of sexual exploitation is unfounded.

14. Further, ID/OIOS concludes that [REDACTED]'s claim [REDACTED] against [REDACTED] is not credible, and that [REDACTED] did not assault [REDACTED] as initially alleged by [REDACTED]. Accordingly, these allegations against [REDACTED] [REDACTED] are unsubstantiated.

15. ID/OIOS recommends that the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] provide a copy of this report to the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] to inform them of the circumstances of the case and the outcome of the investigation [REDACTED].
