

**OBJET: Dossier investigation report into an allegation of attempted rape and assault by [Redacted]**

1. On [Redacted], the Investigations Division of the Office of Internal Oversight Services (ID/OIOS) received from [Redacted], allegations of attempted rape and assault against [Redacted] (hereinafter referred to as [Redacted]), a [Redacted] to the [Redacted]. At the time of the alleged incidents, [Redacted] was [Redacted], [Redacted] and [Redacted] with [Redacted], [Redacted] and [Redacted] in [Redacted]. The allegations were investigated by [Redacted], who cleared [Redacted] of any wrongdoing.

2. Specifically, it was alleged [Redacted] (hereinafter referred to as [Redacted]) that:

(a) On the [Redacted] while staying [Redacted] (hereinafter referred to as [Redacted]) was awoken by [Redacted] later identified this person as [Redacted], who had partially [Redacted] and was attempting to [Redacted] without [Redacted] consent. But, when [Redacted] the [Redacted] fled the premises and [Redacted] went back to sleep;

(b) The following night, on [Redacted], [Redacted] approached [Redacted] and offered [Redacted] in exchange for sex. [Redacted] promised to give [Redacted] an additional [Redacted] the next day. [Redacted] refused [Redacted] offer at which time [Redacted] and threw [Redacted]—resulting in an injury to [Redacted]. [Redacted] left the scene when a passing [Redacted] shown on them; the [Redacted] stopped and conveyed [Redacted] located at the [Redacted] was unable to identify the [Redacted].

(c) [Redacted], who offered [Redacted] did not report the matter to [Redacted]. According to [Redacted] refused the offer and walked to [Redacted] where [Redacted] reported the incidents.

3. ID/OIOS conducted an investigation into these allegations, which included [REDACTED] and the subject. ID/OIOS also reviewed and analyzed relevant documents, including the [REDACTED] investigation file.

4. ID/OIOS has now concluded its investigation and found no independent witnesses to the alleged incident of [REDACTED]. Despite the fact that there were other occupants [REDACTED] at the time of the alleged attempted rape, no one heard [REDACTED] calling for help. The only circumstantial evidence came from [REDACTED] where the alleged attempted rape took place. [REDACTED] stated that around [REDACTED] visited [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] refused because [REDACTED] did not have any [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] further stated that [REDACTED] heard no one screaming, as alleged by [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED] confronted [REDACTED] the following day, demanding the name of [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] as this person—according to [REDACTED]—attempted to rape [REDACTED] then told [REDACTED] the name of [REDACTED].

5. In addition, ID/OIOS found no independent witnesses to the alleged incident of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was unable to identify [REDACTED], who conveyed [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] and despite extensive inquiries, ID/OIOS could not locate any other witness who saw a [REDACTED] in the area at the relevant time. The [REDACTED], who examined [REDACTED] after the alleged assault, informed ID/OIOS that [REDACTED] had no visible injuries, including injuries to the [REDACTED].

6. ID/OIOS was also unable to corroborate the allegation that [REDACTED] had offered bribes to [REDACTED] in an effort to dissuade [REDACTED] from reporting the matter [REDACTED]. ID/OIOS interviewed [REDACTED], identified as the only [REDACTED] in [REDACTED], who could communicate in [REDACTED] and was [REDACTED] on the [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED], a person matching [REDACTED] description came to [REDACTED] appeared to be angry and was looking [REDACTED] advised the [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was not present. [REDACTED] denied that [REDACTED] offered any inducements to [REDACTED] stating that [REDACTED] walked away when [REDACTED] tried to talk [REDACTED].

7. [REDACTED] admitted that [REDACTED] visit [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] at left after [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] for money. [REDACTED] denied that [REDACTED] attempted to have sexual intercourse with [REDACTED] said that on [REDACTED] met [REDACTED] at the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was walking with [REDACTED] into [REDACTED] when [REDACTED] put [REDACTED] hands in [REDACTED] pockets. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] pushed [REDACTED] away and [REDACTED] fell [REDACTED] denied assaulting [REDACTED] or soliciting [REDACTED] for sex.

8. Although the evidence set forth above suggests interaction between [REDACTED]—at least on [REDACTED]—in the absence of corroborative evidence, ID/OIOS is unable to substantiate the allegations against [REDACTED]. Accordingly, ID/OIOS recommends that the [REDACTED] inform the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] that the allegations of attempted rape and assault against [REDACTED] are unsubstantiated. [REDACTED]
