SUBJECT: Closure report on misconduct by [REDACTED]

1. [REDACTED] the Investigations Division of the Office of Internal Oversight Services (ID/OIOS) received a report of possible misconduct implicating [REDACTED]
2. Specifically it was reported that [REDACTED] of [REDACTED]. More specifically, [REDACTED] had created [REDACTED] about the [REDACTED] in which [REDACTED] listed the [REDACTED].
3. ID/OIOS conducted an investigation into the reported misconduct, which included interviews with [REDACTED] witnesses and [REDACTED]. ID/OIOS also collected and reviewed relevant documents, open source material including books, previous [REDACTED] or other public information.
4. The ID/OIOS investigation is now complete. ID/OIOS found that:
 - a. there was no evidence that [REDACTED] had or abuse [REDACTED] position with [REDACTED] to obtain this information other than through causal conversations with [REDACTED] and open source materials.
 - b. upon learning that some of [REDACTED] are concerned over this matter [REDACTED] immediately began to remove the [REDACTED] from the [REDACTED]. The complainant had listed [REDACTED] that had [REDACTED] constructed. Of those [REDACTED] remain. [REDACTED] of which are [REDACTED], the remaining are no longer [REDACTED].

5. ID/OIOS concludes that there is no credible evidence to substantiate the report of misconduct by [REDACTED].
